After reading chapters 5 through 9, please do a research into the five (5) topics using either an online library, books, journal, online articles. After you locate your sources/articles, write a three-paragraph on each individual topic (all five, Don’t Burn Bridges, Mentor and Have a Mentor, Lead Like Jesus, You Have an Enemy and Stay Humble) from your sources. **Remember**, you cannot plagiarized, (copy and paste from your research/articles, etc.). Please understand that you should craft your own thoughts, words from your researched articles/findings. Point will be deducted from your submitted paper.

Guidelines for Submission: Write 1 to 3 paragraphs for each of the five (5) topics. Follow the ASSIGNMENT Page Submittal EXAMPLE, found on the DAST Document Library Page, you can use this page and change the information to suit you. Your Research should be set at 1” from the top of the page, 1” left and right and 1” from the bottom, typed double space, using Times New Roman font.
